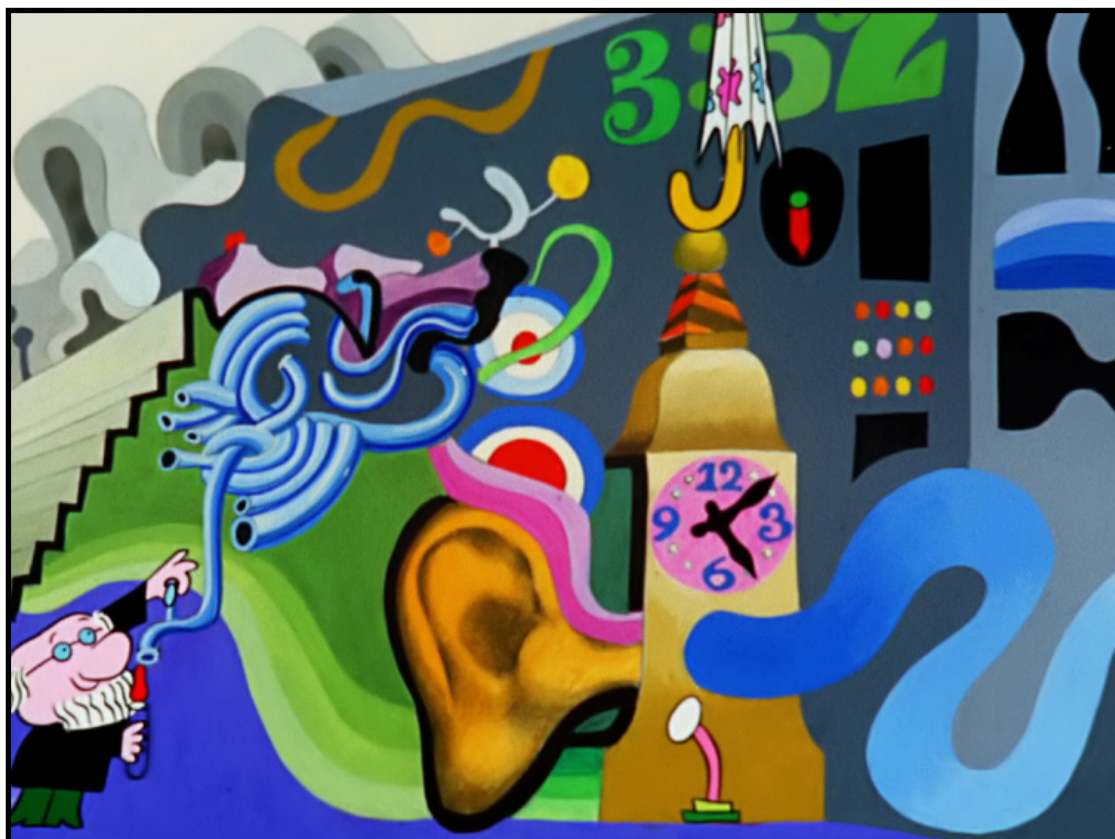

TAILORS OF YOUTH WORK

Europe Goes Local - Study visit to Croatia 2020



Youth work is strongly grounded in youth needs and interest and therefore reflects local realities. That asks for close cooperation of youth workers, local/regional authorities and young people. Also, creative thinking about diverse, innovative and fun interventions is very much needed.

This study visit to Croatia will give you a chance to meet several young people, youth workers and authority representatives who are making sure that the youth work is tailored to youth needs, interest and local realities. Basically you will get a chance to meet modern professor Balthazars. They all have diverse expertises and focus on different topics and use different methods but they all contributed a lot to youth work development in their communities. During this study visit you will get an opportunity to visit three communities (Zagreb, Karlovac and Rijeka) where they live and work and explore different topics and methods that they use.

Professor Balthazar is a Croatian animated television series for children about an old inventor that was produced between 1967 and 1978. In each episode someone has a problem and professor Balthazar tries to help. He then activates a magical machine and produces an invention that will solve the problem.
